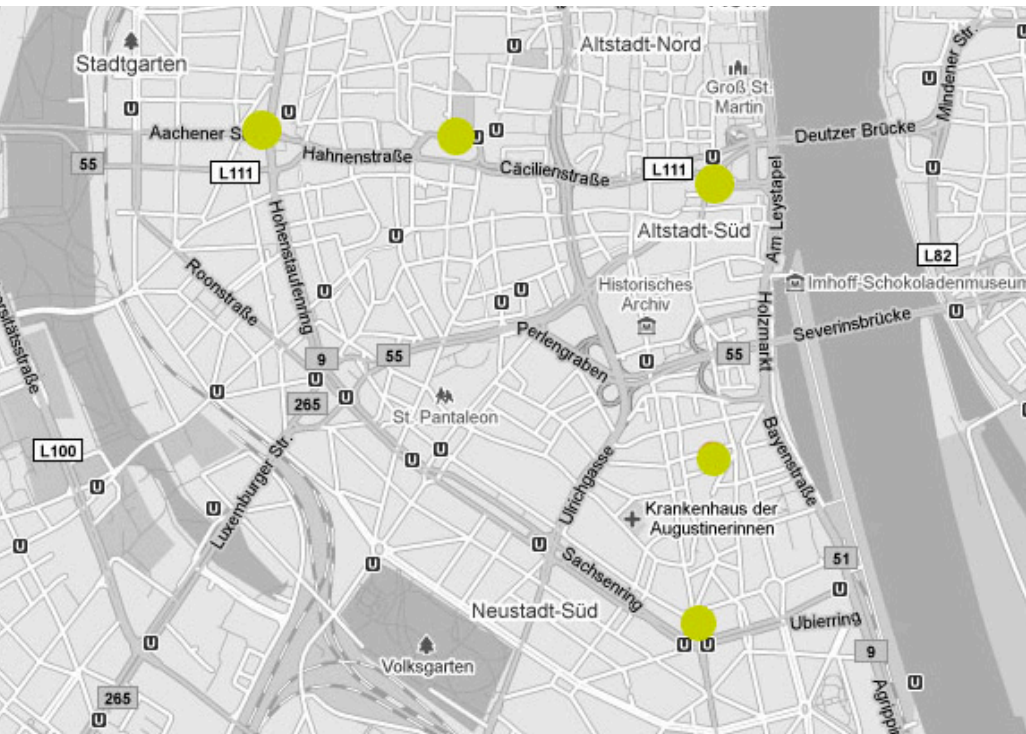

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INTERVIEWS ON BUS STOPS

- >> 35 interviews on different bus stops in Cologne
- >> 21 to 83 years old

- >> Interesting is the interaction of waiting people with the given surroundings on bus stops

- >> where they want to go
- >> age
- >> having children or not

- >> different groups of people and their interaction with the bus stops can be found

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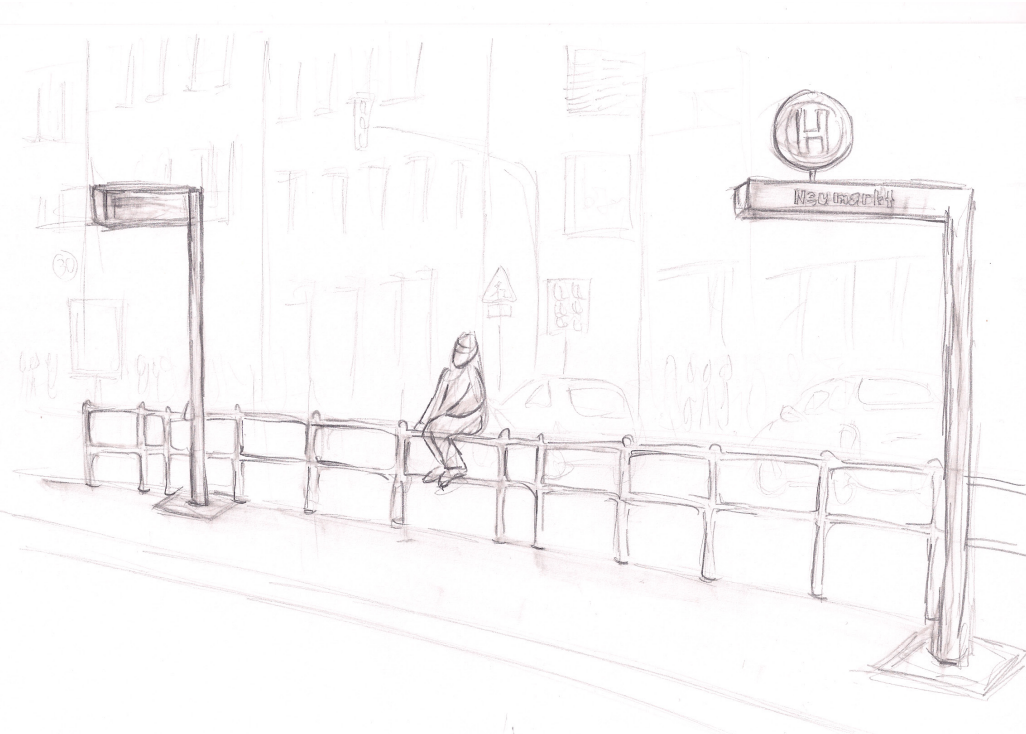

How much can it be reduced?

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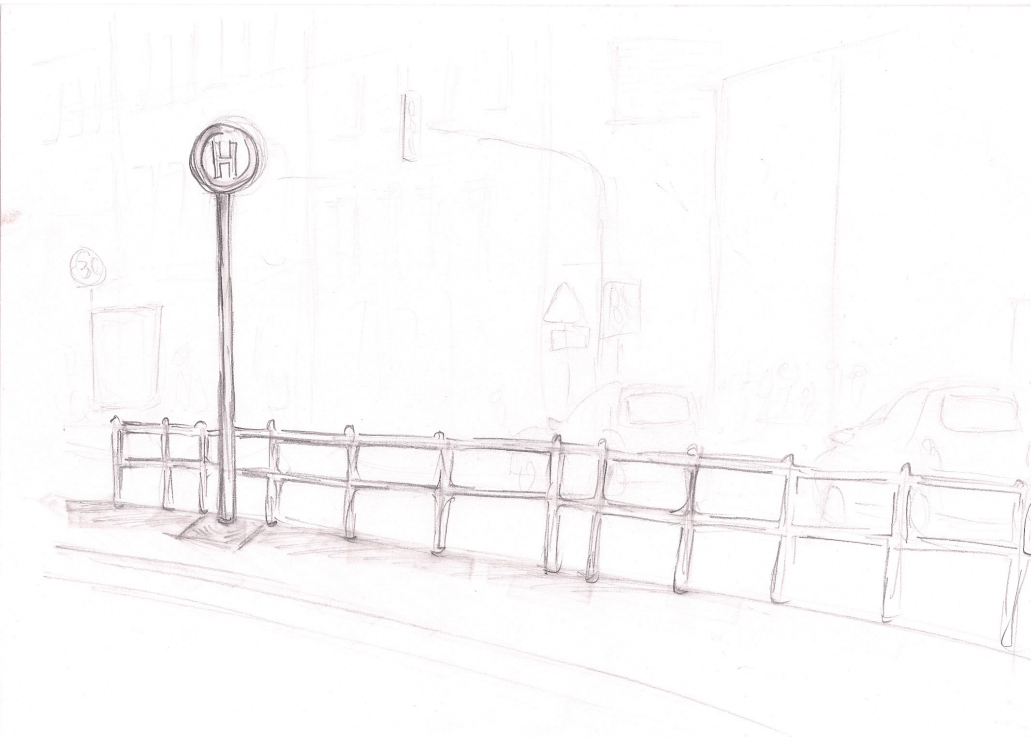


TRANSFORMATION: THE ESSENCE OF A BUS STOP
