

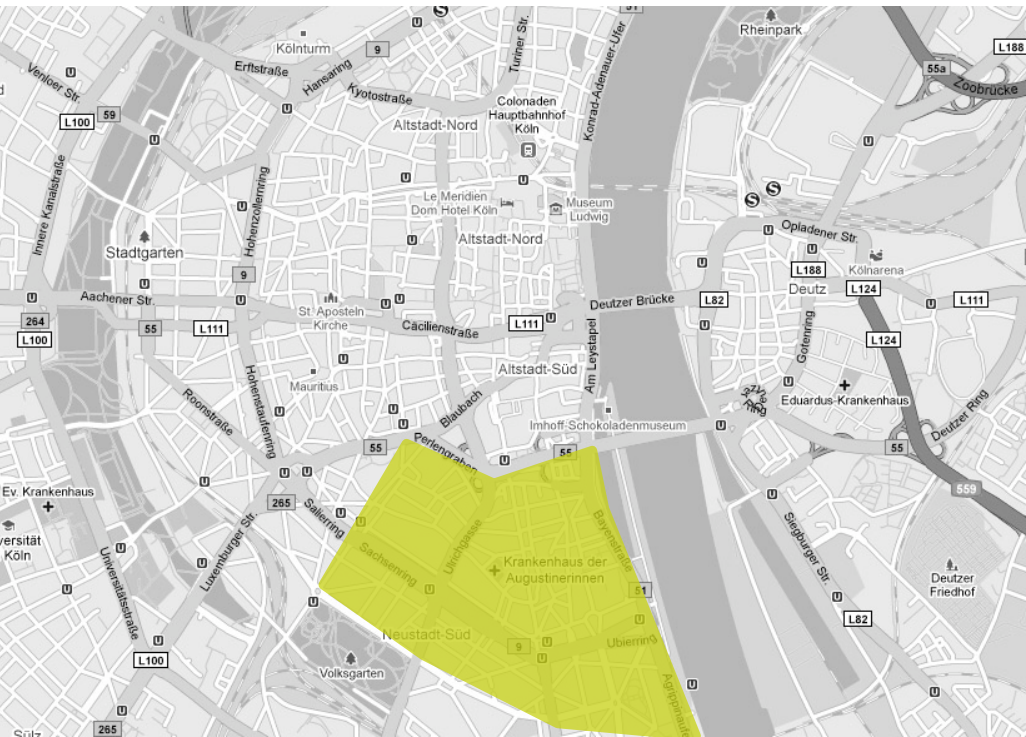

1 - OBSERVATION

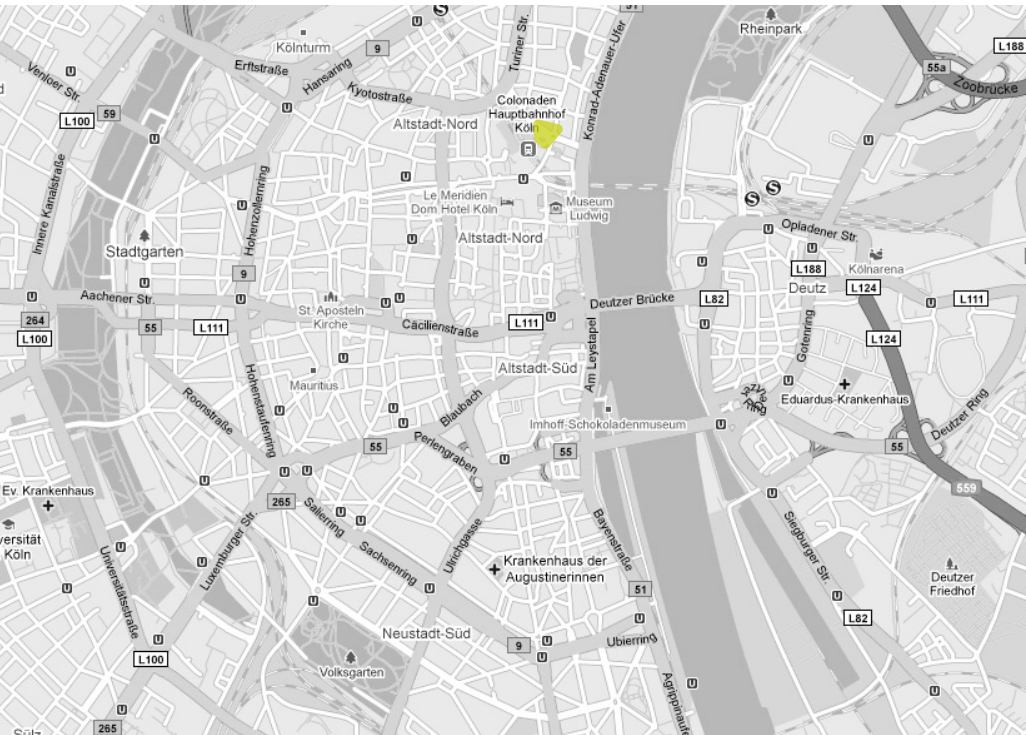
OBSERVATION : Südstadt

DISTANCE : 3.3 km

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CAR PARKING PLACES

How is the parking situation in cologne?

How does a typical parking place look like?

What are the rules and the laws?

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CAR PARKING

How do the people park?

- >> most of the cars are parked in the marked parking spaces
- >> some are parked partly in marked spaces

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SHORT-TIME PARKING

How do the people proceed and interact with the car/parking place?

- >> aware of the situation, but proceed to own advantage
- >> not aware of the situation, but balance it, and decide afterwards

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TRANSFORMATION

When a parking situation or the consequences are unclear or ambiguous, a potential carparker tends to decide according to his/her own advantage. When a parking situation is clearly defined, the parker tends to decide according to his/her consequences.

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TRANSFORMATION QUESTIONS

How could a simplification of the parking-situation affect the decisions of the parker?

What can make the people more responsible?

How big is the influence of unconscious decisions and feelings on the parking?

How do get people to act not egoistically when parking?
